


YOUNG CHILDREN & WINDOW CORDS DON'T MIX

CORDED WINDOW COVERINGS ARE ONE OF THE TOP 5 HIDDEN HAZARDS IN AMERICAN HOMES - *Consumer Product Safety Commission*

YOUR WINDOW COVERINGS COULD POSE A **STRANGULATION RISK** TO YOUR YOUNG ONES.



INSTALL ONLY CORDLESS WINDOW COVERINGS OR THOSE WITH INACCESSIBLE CORDS IN HOMES WITH YOUNG CHILDREN.



TO MAXIMIZE WINDOW CORD SAFETY WHEN YOUNG CHILDREN ARE PRESENT, PARENTS ARE URGED TO FOLLOW THESE SAFETY GUIDELINES:



REPLACE WINDOW BLINDS, CORDED SHADES AND DRAPERIES WITH PRODUCTS THAT ARE CORDLESS OR HAVE INACCESSIBLE CORDS, SUCH AS THOSE MARKED WITH THE "BEST FOR KIDS" LABEL CERTIFICATION, AVAILABLE AT MAJOR RETAILERS IN THE U.S.

MOVE ALL CRIBS, BEDS, FURNITURE AND TOYS AWAY FROM WINDOWS AND WINDOW CORDS, PREFERABLY TO ANOTHER WALL.



ENSURE THAT ALL WINDOW CORDS ARE OUT OF SIGHT AND REACH, BY SHORTENING OR TYING THEM UP AND AWAY, SO THAT THEY ARE INACCESSIBLE TO YOUNG CHILDREN.
